

AADI, ATTAPADI

One-day Study Camp for 35 students was conducted by AADI in collaboration with the Rotary club, Palakkad. We are in dialogue with them for greater participation in the field of remedial education for adivasi students.

Ooru utsavam will be at night after 8 p.m. and may go till daybreak with dances, songs, kooth and instructional talks on culture and life. The first of this kind is going to be on 1st April 2015.

Over fifteen thousand people gathered to pressurise the Govt. to complete Right Bank Canal project. The agitation was led by the Diocese of Sultanpet. Archbishop Soosa Pakiam and six other bishops along with many political leaders addressed the gathering. We, a small group of people from St Antony's church, Nellipathy, were also part of this great agitation.

The versatile **P. S. Antony** soon after rocking Kozhinjampara area with his words and songs for RBC agitation gave a five-day retreat to the nurses of ICC Hospital, Coimbatore.

Many fondly remembered the Hindi Bhajan that I had taught them: "JAYA YESU! JAYA NAAM!" I arrived on the eve of a special day – NYEPI DAY 2015 – the ANNUAL DAY of SILENCE in BALI. You can check it online. Everything came to a standstill from 6.00 a.m. on MARCH 21 to 6.00 a.m. on MARCH 22. The Airport was closed; all the roads were closed; all the places of worship were closed; all the TV Channels were closed. No bright lights or sounds were allowed in any building; no one was allowed to move out of the house or hotel. There were even Hindu vigilantes to see that the Law and Tradition was strictly observed. During the day on MARCH 22 and in the evening, there was a series of Hindu Balinese entertainment, including the Fire Dance. Balinese food is very spicy! The Church was packed to overflowing for the anticipated MASS as well as for all the 4 PALM SUNDAY MASSES, including the one in English after which I met 2 Indian families (one Malayali, the other Goan), Australians, Canadians and others. I am directing the Community Retreat of some Sisters of this Parish. May we all experience the power of Christ's Resurrection!
